- 1. In order to be eligible for any player of the year award, the player must have competed in at least one NHGA event where points are awarded.
- 2. In order to be eligible for the Kirk Hanefeld Junior Player of the Year award, players must meet age requirements.

5th & Ties

- 3. Junior players competing in Thomas J. Leonard Jr. Player of the Year events shall receive bonus points per the above points breakdown. Bonus points will be awarded in the Player of the Year standings applicable to the player and will only be available on that specific list.
- 4. Players must compete in all rounds of the New Hampshire Open, New England Amateur or any Regional Open to be eligible to receive points.
- 5. Players competing in team events will only receive 1/2 of the allotted points if they are the only Junior or Senior player on the team.
- 6. All team points are per player.
- 7. Stroke Play Series points will be awarded based on field size. If field is only 75% filled, or has no more than 32 players, 1/2 points will be awarded. If the field is only %50 filled or has no more than 21 players, 1/4 points will be awarded. Total points for POY will be capped at 60.
- 8. A player receives all points for qualifying in USGA events after qualifying is completed. A player receives all points for a USGA Championship after the championship proper has been completed.
- 9. If any player wins a USGA Championship, they will be no less than co-player of the year.
