# JANE BLALOCK



Jane Blalock was born in Portsmouth, NH and has spent her lifetime in competitive golf. She had an impressive amateur career both locally and at Rollins College. Jane won three New Hampshire Women's Amateur titles and was the first woman from New Hampshire to win the New England Women's Amateur.

Blalock had an extremely successful career in professional golf. She won over thirty events worldwide over two decades and had a twelve year stretch of not missing a cut in a professional tournament. Additionally, she finished in the top ten of the LPGA money list for nine consecutive seasons.

Jane started JBC Golf in 1987, which manages "LPGA Golf Clinics for Women", a series of events held nationwide. In 2000, she helped create the Legends Tour and serves as the tour's CEO. Ms. Blalock is the author of two books, has received numerous awards for volunteerism, has been named to various regional and national boards and has been honored in numerous Halls of Fame.
