<b>Notes:</b>	
1. In order to be eligible for any player of the year award, the player must have competed in at least one NHGA event where points are awarded.	
2. Seniors must be 55 years old to be eligible for the Senior Tri-State Championship.	
3. Senior players competing in Thomas J. Leonard Jr. Player of the Year events shall receive bonus points per the above points breakdown. Bonus points will be awarded in the Player of the Year standings applicable to the player and will only be available on that specific list.	
4. Players must compete in all rounds of the New Hampshire Open, New England Amateur or any Regional Open to be eligible to receive points.	
5. Players competing in team events will only receive 1/2 of the allotted points if they are the only Senior player on the team.	
6. All team points are per player.	
7. A player receives all points for qualifying in USGA events after qualifying is completed. A player receives all points for a USGA Championship after the championship proper has been completed.
